CALL TO ORDER: 7:00

MINUTES JANUARY 7, 2019: Motion made and seconded to approve the minutes of the January 7, 2019 minutes. Motion passed unanimously.

60th ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION COMMITTEE REPORT: In Patrick's absence, Nancy Lohman shared plans for this 2020 celebration. The 60th Anniversary year will begin with a free concert for the community October 13, 2019. The Christmas concert will be December 8, 2019 and Patrick is considering doing afternoon and evening performances. The Spring concert, March 15, 2020, will be an alumni homecoming event and will feature past singers and directors. April 15, 2020 will be a combined concert with the Holland Symphony Orchestra at the Jack Miller Auditorium with performances at 3:30 and 7:30. The Holland Chorale will not be part of Tulip Time 2020 because of the other spring events already scheduled.

Nancy said that a 60th Anniversary Logo is being designed and they are exploring other ways to be visible in the community and have more media presence throughout the year. Patrick is open to ideas from board members. The board recommended that the 60th anniversary committee schedule a Skype meeting with Patrick before his Sabbatical return in the spring, to address things like travel expenses for former directors, expected luncheon expenses, etc., and firm up a budget to present to the Executive Committee by March 18, 2019. The Grand Night for Singing Committee (May 23, 2019), would like a video or some other promotional materials to spark interest in the upcoming Anniversary year.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT:

 NEW BOARD MEMBERS & RECRUITMENT COMMITTEE DISCUSSION AND REPORTS: Several board members were tasked with talking to potential future board members before the January 2019 meeting. TREASURER'S REPORT: The current checking account balance is \$13,218. The Executive Committee 2020 Budget Draft meeting will be March 18, 2019. The Board of Directors Budget Draft meeting will be April 8, 2019. Julie will need to have 60th anniversary expenses built in by those dates. Also, she questioned how having a free Fall concert and two, rather than one, Christmas concerts would affect the budget.

TICKETS: Nine individual tickets have been sold for the March concert in addition to very few season subscriptions. Discussion led to Brian and Jean agreeing to contact area church music directors, asking them to promote Holland Chorale concerts. Sally pointed out that Tulip Time 2019 is promoting A Gift of Nature on their website events page, but the Holland Chorale name is not under the concert title. Brian and Carol Z. will contact the Tulip Time office and Sally will point this out to Jennifer.

STRATEGIC PLANNING: Jean reported that she met with Pam W., Jennifer and Patrick in November. They decided that it is time for a complete overhaul of the mission and values statements. This process will likely take at least a year to complete and they have a possible consultant to guide them. Some statement will be required before the next MCACA grant applications is filed.
