

Proposed plan for 2022-23 Season...

Fall, 2022:

- Current plan is to once again hold GRAND NIGHT FOR SINGING in September. We have had discussion about how to make GNFS available to anyone who wants to sing. Cost of dinner for the entire chorale is prohibitive, but we will brainstorm ways to make the opportunity available for members who want to sing in the ensemble selections only.
- Chorale's first "full-length" concert would be our Holiday Concert. In early fall, that enables us to have a community and education focus, and to have sufficient time to prepare well for the Holiday performance. Dr. VandenBrink and I are planning a Zoom meeting to discuss community engagement opportunities.
- Because of school and student schedules, ADVENTURES IN HARMONY will remain in early October. The educational component (rehearsal and mass choir performance) will remain the same, but the evening showcase will have fewer guest performers to give more performance time for Chorale. This will be a treble voices year for AIH, but no real reason why the Tenors/Basses of Chorale couldn't perform as well.
- Concurrent with the treble voices' preparation for AIH, Tenors/Basses will prepare for a high school tour, working with the school choral directors as we originally planned for 2021

Winter and Spring, 2022:

- Current plans for a late winter/early spring concert (early or mid-March?), and final concert in late April / early May, possibly again in conjunction with Tulip Time.
